## **DEFINITIONS**

<b>Speech</b>	excludes advertising, trails, sponsor credits and the like and is calculated over a specific period to be approx 25% of daytime output and involve information relevant to, and likely to be appreciated by, listeners in the area and/or likely to be supportive of community links.
<b>Music</b>	Music policy strives to include Gaelic, Scottish traditional, Celtic, Scottish dance, folk, jazz, world, classical, spiritual, country, big band, modern, rock and popular music, although no one genre should make up more than 40% of the music output
<b>Peak Times</b>	refers to weekday breakfast and afternoon drive output, and weekend late breakfast
<b>Daytime</b>	between the hours of 0730 and 1900 weekdays and 0900 to 1400 weekends
<b>Locally Made</b>	refers to output produced and presented within the licence area and includes peak time. The station reflects the particular culture of the area and significant prominence is given to broadcasting in Gaelic. At least 2 hours each week of Gaelic language programmes made locally and further Gaelic output may be presented that is produced by other local Scottish station. No programmes are broadcast which simulcast or repeat and other ILR programmes produced and presented in Cuillin FM's transmission area.

### **NEWS BULLETIN SCHEDULES**

Cuillin FM broadcasts National News reports via their sustaining service on the hour, with the exceptions of 7pm through to and including 11pm. Local News is broadcast on the Breakfast and Dol Dhachaigh shows daily straight after the national news. Local news is collated through the assistance of local communities and resources such as newspaper media.

### **PROGRAMME SCHEDULE**

A sample programme schedule is available on the website ([www.cuillinfm.co.uk](http://www.cuillinfm.co.uk)) and can be obtained at any time by calling the station on 01478 611797 and either leaving your details or calling in and picking up a copy. Programme schedules are subject to change as we are a community radio station relying on volunteer presenters. Where possible, these changes are announced in advance of the changed programme(s).

Cuillin FM broadcasts live 75hours a week and the remainder of the broadcasting is provided through a national sustaining service

The station has a duty to provide 3 hours of Gaelic programming per week but we aim to provide at least 6 hours with this increasing in the near future.

It is also part of Cuillin FM's remit to provide programming for and including participation from local communities. Programmes such as Youth Programmes and Strupag take this into consideration but we aim to increase this within 12 months of this report.

We also have outside broadcasting facilities for charity, community event coverage, such as The Highland Games, Piping Festivals, Battle of the Bands, Youth Speaks, etc. We have also held special extended Breakfast Shows to raise monies for MacMillan Cancer Relief.

## **STATION PLAYLIST**

It is Cuillin FM's intention to cover all types of music from Rock to Classical, including local musicians, traditional music, easy listening, jazz, comedy, etc. We wish to appeal to all ages from the local community who use Cuillin FM.
